PRO 4.20 RULES

Class is for fully body, side steer door cars and trucks.

1/8 mile heads up – Pro tree- chip draw eliminations

Higher qualified car gets lane choice in round one.

Faster car in previous round gets lane choice thereafter.

Any run faster than 4.20 is disqualified.

If both cars fun faster than 4.20 in any elimination round, the car that ran closest to 4.20 is the winner.

Beyond a "red light start" First or worst rule applies. Red Light – Race is over

All cars must have one working tail light minimum.

All vehicles must meet NHRA Safety Requirements for ET and speed.

Any internal combustion engine allowed with any modifications.

One power adder permitted.

No cubic inch limit.

No weight requirements.

Any transmission allowed.

Any rear tire permitted

Racing gasoline, alcohol, ethanol permitted.

Nitromethane and propylene oxide prohibited.

Throttle Stops prohibited (Pneumatic, Electric, Hydraulic)
